If.

If tomorrow were your last day...

What do you suppose would happen to you?

If you died...

Where do you suppose you would go?

Have you ever thought of this?

When a Christian is asked all of this they instantly know they will be in heaven.

They answer with all confidence.

How?

Why?

They have True Faith, that what the Bible explains is True.

Upon death the soul separates from the body and travels instantly to a destination.

For the Christian this is heaven.

For all others this is hell.

I know that may sound extreme to you, but it is true.

For those who cannot answer the question...

They pause or they say ' I don't know" — Your destination is hell.

You do not want to be in hell.

It is the abode of Death & the Grave.

They are two spirits that reside and rule there.

There are many parts & depths to hell.

Some areas are more intense than others.

But for all there, it is torture, fearful & without rest or food, drink or anything positive.

How can this be?

When sin entered the world, a place needed to be made to hold those who chose sin,

Until the time of the final judgement & the lake of eternal fire.

People do not go directly to the lake of eternal fire, right away.

Depending on the year of entry, it is a thousand years, up to six-thousand years of being held in hell and tortured before the final judgement.

Only those who did not follow Me,

or Believe and Obey My Son are sent to hell.

In days of Old it was referred to as, The Pit.

This is the same place as Hell.

Demons are allowed to torture people continually who end up in hell.
Constant and total irritation with pain, fear, darkness, etc.
Nothing good is allowed to exist in hell.
Jesus was sent to hell to defeat death when he died on the cross.
And he did, and then returned to life, creating a pathway for eternal life for all who follow Him.

Why?

Sin has a price.
There is a legal system in heaven.
No one with sin can enter in.
So in the days of old, a sacrificial animal had to be traded for people's sin, in order for them to be seen as forgiven.
But Christ became the final sacrifice, once for all.
Because he died and conquered death, now all humans who come to Me under His blood covering are seen as sin free, and forgiven.
It means He was the final sacrifice and His blood or the physical sacrifice that he made was the Cure, and effectively, legally can cover all who choose to believe, follow, obey and submit to His leadership.
All who come— every one is covered, legally in heaven.
No one can choose for another person.
Each person must choose the way of life to become a Christian on their own.
Each one must live the life of faith in obedience.
Each one must stop sinning, and aim at becoming like Christ,
as directed by the Holy Spirit.
Every one must be baptized in to water.
For legally nothing can be Holy unless it passes through fire or water.
Clearly water is the proper choice for a human.

There are many things unknown about heaven's systems.
They are not for you to know unless you are a resident of heaven.

This is why there are rules in My Word.
I simply state how to live.
Those that comply are living in ways that have eternal benefits.
Those that rebel and live in their own way,
they have eternal consequences.
Either you trust me, the Lord God Almighty, or you do not.
It is that simple.

Those that trust Me, obey in faith.
Faith is believing things which cannot be fully seen,
but have been laid in the heart & one knows it is true.
Faith is not swayed by what man says.
Faith acts based on what the spirit knows to be true.
The spirit runs the man.

If your spirit is filled with My Holy Spirit,
you will be directed by Him to obey and live like Jesus.
If a different spirit runs you, then you will live carnally, selfishly, in the flesh.
Read Romans to see what this means.

I AM the Lord God Almighty.
I do not lie.
This is Truth.

If you choose to follow Jesus and you choose to listen to the Holy Spirit,
You will be growing consistently and changed into being Christlike, gradually.
You will feel a twinge to stop doing behaviors that are carnal, fleshly, and selfish.

If you do not obey, the Holy Spirit warnings,
to be pushed away from evil, darkness and wickedness,
then you will be doing what is called, stifling the Holy Spirit.

When this is done repeatedly,
the Holy Spirit is grieved because you are willfully not listening to Him
and you are willfully allowing other spirits to guide your life.
This is how a person is led to slaughter.

Small daily choices that either feed the carnal or allow the Holy Spirit to rule and grow them.
A Christian who was seemingly saved, can be so irresponsible & crave the carnal to the point that they
can walk away from Me completely.

How?

If they do not one step on the legal process, like be baptized or if they deny the Holy Spirit, they are
not secure in their salvation.

However, if in covenant and obedient a Christian is in True Faith, it is impossible for them to be
derailed and make them walk away from Me.

Can they still have negative habits and influences?

Yes.

But, the Holy Spirit will lovingly and gradually make them aware to next work on a problem area
or suddenly be made aware and feel bad about behaving or interacting with something.

The Holy Spirit can direct them to see or hear a verse from the Bible that stands out
anew and convicts them in their spirit that they are making a mistake and need
to repent and change, stopping a habit or behavior.

They will be made to understand there needs to be a change.

These are called convictions of the Holy Spirit.

These convictions gently and in a particular order which is unique to each person,
brings each believer step by step closer to Christlikeness.

A Real Christian, in covenant with Christ,
knows in their soul, what habit, or behavior needs to change
and then they repent or stop and pray for forgiveness and ask for help with changing.

Those who are serious about the change use communion.

For it symbolizes of Jesus' Holy Blood poured out for them,
and His broken body sacrificed for them.

This process brings My Power to the person to enable them to Change.

The difference between the Christian who is in covenant and one who is not fully in covenant is that the one in covenant is fully led by the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit is the only spirit that guides them.

The one not in covenant, does believe and is associated with Christianity,

but if they are not led by the Holy Spirit this means another spirit leads them,

If another spirit leads them then this means legally in heaven they are not sanctified,
not holy.

They are not secure in their salvation until they correct what is wrong, and invite the Holy Spirit back in to lead.

These people must often pray to have their chains broken,

for other spirits, when they run a man's soul, do so by force.

They(the other spirits) latch on and will not leave unless forced.

When requested I send My Holy Angels to defeat the demons and spirits that rule.

My Angels defend the person so they can fully hear & follow the Holy Spirit.

To grieve the Holy Spirit is to ignore Him and allow other spirits to lead.

If you die, and your soul is in a spiritual state and not led by the Holy Spirit
your soul goes to hell.

This is not what many people think is true.

Read the Bible and see.

Ask Me to help you understand,

and I will give anyone who truly seeks to be obedient, the Truth.

Pray.

Ask.

Read.

Then when you are asked— "If" ...

You will know.

Either heaven or hell.

I do encourage you to follow the Holy Spirit.

He is the gift for all who accept Jesus with Full Faith and obedience as the One True Messiah who can
bring them eternal salvation.

This is the way to be secure or know for sure, that if you died tomorrow...

Your soul would go to heaven.

Let Me ask again.

If you died tomorrow... What would happen to your soul?

24 and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

1 John 2:6

6 He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

Heb 10:5-10

5 Therefore, when He came into the world, He said:
"Sacrifice and offering You did not desire,
But a body You have prepared for Me.
6 In burnt offerings and *sacrifices* for sin
You had no pleasure.
7 Then I said, 'Behold, I have come—
In the volume of the book it is written of Me—
To do Your will, O God.' "
8 Previously saying, "Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and *offerings* for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure *in them*" (which are offered according to the law),
9 then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second.
10 By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all*.
11 And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.
12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God,
13 from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool.
14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.
15 But the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us; for after He had said before,
16 "This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them,"
17 *then He adds*, "Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."
18 Now where there is remission of these, *there is* no longer an offering for sin.

Romans 1:18-31

18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, 19 because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown *it* to them. 20 For since the creation of the world His invisible *attributes* are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, 21 because, although they knew God, they did not glorify *Him* as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. 22 Professing to be wise, they became fools, 23 and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.

24 Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, 25 who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

26 For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. 27 Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.

28 And even as they did not like to retain God in *their* knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; 29 being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; *they are* whisperers, 30 backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, 31 undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful; 32 who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.

Col 2:6-7

As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him

Acts 2:22-23

22 "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know—

23 Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death;

24 whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it.
